SECTION C: Requirements for a Large Pitch (over 3m x 3m)

If your stall requires a pitch larger than the Standard Pitch (3m x 3m) eg because it contains a vehicle or an extra-large gazebo, then you will need to apply for a Large Pitch. The charge for each additional metre wider than the Standard 3m frontage width is £25.00 per metre.

To help us understand exactly how you would like to configure your pitch, please draw a diagram. Your diagram must include:

- The overall size of your whole pitch area (width x depth) in cm or m;
- Any vehicle measurements and the placement on your pitch;
- Total maximum frontage and depth of your stall.
